


Crochet direction (valid for all crochet patterns)



Fillet crochet fast course

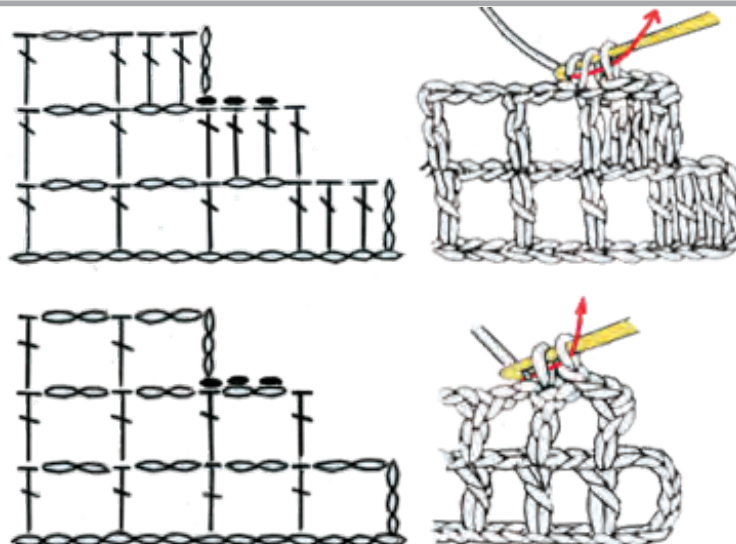
Meshtyp	sign	Working method
<p><i>Chain stitch</i></p> 		 <p>Form a loop, wrap the yarn over around the crochet hook, pull the crochet hook through the oop from left to right, repeat continuously.</p>
<p><i>Single crochet</i></p>		 <p>On the previous row: insert the crochet hook into the next stitch, pull the thread through the stitch from left to right, make 1 yarn over, pull the thread through the 2 loops from left to right</p>
<p><i>Half double crochet</i></p>		 <p>On the previous row: Make 1 yarn over, crochet hook in 4th stitch, pull the thread through this stitch from left to right, 1 yarn over, pull thread through the first 2 stitches, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the remaining 2 loops</p>
<p><i>Double crochet</i></p>		 <p>On the previous row: 3 yarn over, crochet hook in 5th stitch, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the chain stitch of the previous row, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the next 2 loops, 1 yarn over, thread through from ---> continuation page 3</p>



<p><i>Double crochet</i></p>		<p>page 3</p>  <p>left to right Pull the next 2 loops, 1 yarn over, pull the thread from left to right through the remaining 2 loops (Yarn is always pulled through 2 stitches from left to right)</p>
<p><i>Triple crochet</i></p>		 <p>On the previous row: 3 yarn over, crochet hook in 5th stitch, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the chain stitch of the previous row, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the next 2 loops, 1 yarn over, thread through from left to right Pull the next 2 loops, 1 yarn over, pull the thread from left to right through the remaining 2 loops (Yarn is always pulled through 2 stitches from left to right)</p>
<p><i>Slip stitch</i></p>	 <p>On the previous row: the needle is inserted into the next stitch, the thread is fetched and then pulled through one loop or both loops.</p>	
<p><i>Decrease at the beginning of a row</i></p>	 <p>1. For the last unfilled box, crochet 5 loops from right to left with 2 stitches each or 2. crochet 4 slip stitches on the last unfilled box for the next row</p>	

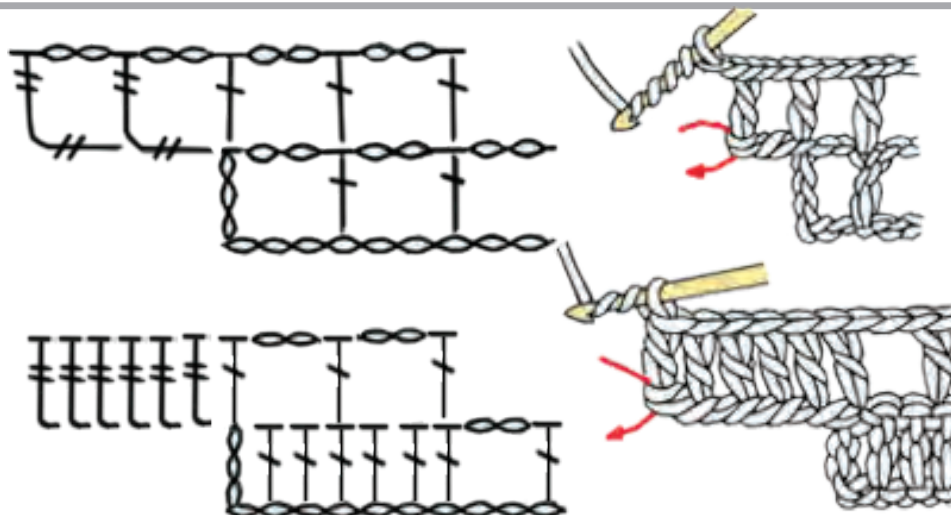


Decrease at the end of a row



1. On the last filled box, crochet 4 slip stitches for the next row
or
2. 4 slip stitches on the last unfilled box crochet for the next row

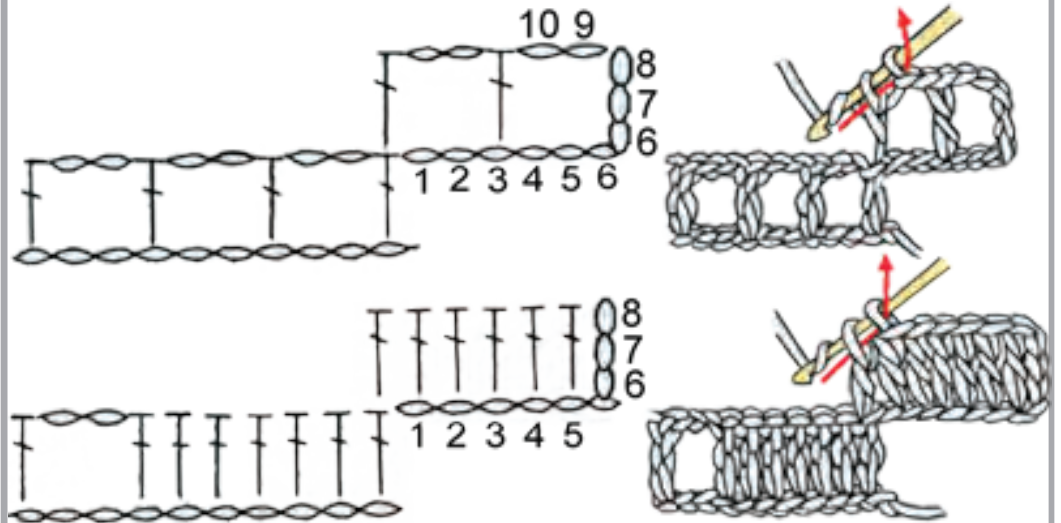
Increase at the beginning of a row



1. Unfilled box
2 chain stitches, 4 yarn overs, insert the needle in the underside of the last half double crochet and pull the thread through from left to right, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the chain stitch of the previous row, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the next 2 loops, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the next 2 loops, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the next 2 loops, 1 yarn over, pull thread from left to right through the remaining 2 loops
2. Filled box
A corresponding number of half double crochets are lined up in a row



Increase at the end of a row



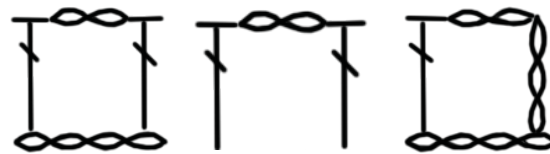
1. Unfilled box

After the last box work 10 chain stitches, put the first half double crochet in the third chain stitch, the second half double crochet is crocheted on the last half double crochet of the previous row

2. Filled box

After the last row, 8 chain stitches are crocheted, the first half double crochet is crocheted on the fifth chain stitch, ..., the sixth half double crochet is crocheted on the last half double crochet of the previous row

Unfilled box



Strung together are 1 half double crochet, 2 chain stitches and 1 half double crochet











At the beginning of a new line the first half double crochet is replaced by three chain stitches for the 1st double crochet.

Filled box







Strung together are 4 half double crochet. At the beginning of a new line the first half double crochet is replaced by three chain stitches for the 1st double crochet.



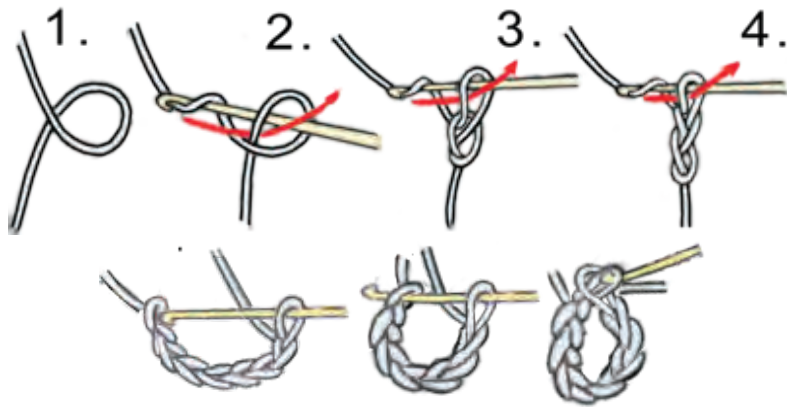
<p><i>Passage for curtain rail</i></p> <p>K</p>	 <p>On the front row are crocheted : (1 half double crochet (or 3 chain stitch or 3 chain stitches for the 1st double crochet), 3 chain stitches, 1 single crochet, 3 chain stitches and 1 half double crochet)</p>
<p><i>Frings</i></p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.  Arrange the thread 2.  Lay the threads in half 3.  Pull the threads through the box with a crochet hook 4.  Twist and tighten the fringes and then cut them to a uniform length 5. 
<p><i>Crochet studs</i></p> 	 <p>On the previous row of <u>a stitch</u> (e.g. half double crochets), for example, 7 half double crochets are crocheted and then stitched together. (The thread is pulled through all 7 loops and fixed with a subsequent single crochet.) The result is a three-dimensional stitch that, for example, can completely fill an unfilled box.</p>
<p><u>Group of half double crochets</u> <u>double crochet</u></p>	 <p>In <u>1 stitch</u> on the previous row (e.g. half double crochet, single crochet, ...) are crocheted several half double crochets.</p>



<p><i>Increase half single crochets</i></p>	 <p>Two or more half double crochets are crocheted together as required. The stitches are first picked up and then pulled through the first loop.</p>
<p><i>Decrease half single crochets</i></p>	 <p>Two or more half single crochets are crocheted together as required. The stitches are first picked up and then pulled through the first loop.</p>
<p><i>Increase single crochets</i></p>	 <p>In <u>one stitch</u> of the previous row, crochet 2 or more single crochets as required.</p>
<p><i>Decrease single crochets stitches</i></p>	 <p>Two or more, e.g. single crochets, are crocheted together as required. The stitches are first picked up and then pulled through the first loop.</p>



*Crochet
in rounds:*



A chain consisting of chain stitches is created, the last chain stitch from this chain is then connected to the starting chain stitch (points 1-7); further 3 chain stitches are crocheted, which are the beginning of the 2nd round. On the existing chain stitches on the first round are crocheted now half double crochets / boxes (between that corresponding chain stitches for the meshes increase). The same procedure is used in the 3rd round and further rounds.
